Suggested Guidelines for International Rhema Day 2017

International Rhema Day has three objectives:

- 1. To **support** Rhema Bible Training College USA financially as it prepares students for ministry.
- 2. To **pray** for Rhema Bible Training College USA, its staff, and the current student body.
- 3. To **share** with others about Rhema Bible Training College USA.

Prior to International Rhema Day:

- Beginning in April, identify Sunday, May 7, as *International Rhema Day* in your church, ministry, or business announcements and/or bulletin. A slide is available at **rhema.org/ird** to help you with this.
- Let church members, partners, and employees know they will have the opportunity to give a special Rhema Day offering on Sunday, May 7.
- Encourage your members to bring anyone who is interested in attending Rhema to the May 7 service.
- Help people understand the important role they play in the future of Rhema Bible Training College USA. An IRD video is also available at **rhema.org/ird** for you to download and share.
- Share the *International Rhema Day* Facebook graphic on your church, ministry or business Facebook page.

On May 7, 2017, explain International Rhema Day's purpose:

- 1. **Support** Rhema Bible Training College USA financially.
 - Present the need to support Rhema Bible Training College USA, and then receive an offering for Rhema. (Show the IRD video to help with this.)
 - Mention that text-to-give is available. (*See the text-to-give information*. A slide is available at **rhema.org/ird**.)
 - Remind your congregation that their support will help train thousands of students for ministry. *Every gift will make a difference!*
- 2. **Pray** for Rhema Bible Training College USA. Here are specific prayer points:
 - Rhema graduates around the world and the current student body
 - Increased RBTC enrollment
 - Increased ministry finances
 - Wisdom for the Hagins, Rhema's instructors, and the ministry staff
- 3. **Share** about Rhema Bible Training College USA.
 - Share with your congregation about what Rhema has done for you and, if applicable, what it means to be a Rhema graduate. If church members, ministry partners, or employees have attended RBTC, ask one or two to speak briefly about the benefits of attending Rhema.
 - Explain the importance of attending Rhema Bible Training College—a school that teaches the Word of God with excellence and integrity.
 - Distribute the RBTC application sheets to those interested. Make extra application sheets available somewhere in your church, ministry, or business.


