## RHEMA College Weekend FAQ

**Q.** What are the dates of the next *RHEMA College Weekend*?

**A.** Friday, April 18–Sunday, April 20, 2007

**Q.** Is there a registration fee?

**A.** Yes. The cost is \$35 per person, which includes a luncheon with Revs. Ken and Lynette Hagin, the school's dean, and instructors. The fee also includes access to the Ninowski Recreation Center during free times and many other planned events.

**Q.** How do I register?

Please have your credit card or check card ready to pay the \$35 fee when you log on or call to register. You may also mail us your registration request and \$35 check or money order to:

**Q.** Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

**A.** Yes, you will receive a confirmation letter, along with several other helpful items that will assist you in preparing for the weekend.

**Q.** If I register and then find out later that I am unable to attend, will the registration fee be refunded?

**A.** No. The \$35 registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

**Q.** What is the minimum age to attend *RHEMA College Weekend*?

**A.** Participants must be at least 16 years old.

**Q.** Will my parents be able to attend with me?

**A.** Yes, we welcome your parents to join you. Please keep in mind, however, that each parent who wishes to attend will also need to register and pay the \$35 registration fee.

**Q.** Is *RHEMA College Weekend* only for those in high school who are considering attending?

**A.** No. Our student body includes people of all ages, backgrounds, races, nationalities, and walks of life. Whether you are preparing to graduate from high school, are a retired professional, or are somewhere in between, *RHEMA College Weekend* is the perfect opportunity for you to experience RHEMA firsthand and hear from God for yourself about the plans and purposes He has for you!

**Q.** Can my children attend *RHEMA College Weekend* with me?

**A.** The minimum age to attend *RHEMA College Weekend* is 16. Younger children, including infants, will not be allowed to join you in the classes or special sessions. The only *RHEMA College Weekend* event open to children under 16 is the Saturday evening Fun Night, and all children must be accompanied at the Fun Night by their parents.

**Q.** Do you have childcare available on campus for the children of *RHEMA College Weekend* guests?

**A.** No. Childcare is not available during any of the events on April 18–19. Children’s Church and Nursery services will be available during the Sunday morning RHEMA Bible Church service on April 20.

**Q.** What time should I arrive on campus to check in?

**A.** Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. on Friday, April 18, with the Welcome Session beginning at 8:00 a.m.

**Q.** What should I bring to campus?

**A.** We recommend that you bring your Bible, a notepad, and a pen. You may also bring a camera (optional).

**Q.** What is the dress code for the weekend?

**A.** Business-casual outfits are appropriate for most events. This dress code consists of dress slacks, pantsuits, blouses, sweaters, and appropriate dress shoes and socks for women (no flip-flops, capris, or cropped pants, please). Dockers-style slacks, dress slacks, collared shirts, sweaters, and dress shoes and socks are in order for men. Please avoid wearing athletic shoes during classes. We encourage you to wear comfortable clothing, such as jeans and tennis shoes, to the Saturday evening Fun Night.

**Q.** Will my children, parents, or friends be able to participate in the Saturday Fun Night? Is there a fee?

**A.** We welcome you to invite your children, parents, and friends to participate in the Saturday Fun Night, which is free.

**Q.** What about hotel accommodations?

**A.** Designated hotels and motels offer special rates for event participants. Ask for the “RHEMA Rate.” See the list of accommodations on the **Hotels/Maps** link.
