



In this modern day of "quick and easy," many Christians want to be able to sit down, say "Thank you, Lord," and receive all God's blessings. Sometimes you have to get up after you pray and put legs to your faith, so to speak.

Now, over the course of possessing all that belongs to you, as you make progress and overcome one obstacle, the devil will put other obstacles in your way. You may say, "I'm getting tired of this." Friend, I want to tell you something. From now until Jesus comes back, you're going to have opportunity after opportunity to prove that God's Word still works!

You may have to take a Jericho March, and you may have setbacks along the way. The enemy may even seem to win a battle. But remember, losing a battle doesn't mean you've lost the war. We all have setbacks, but we keep on marching. The people who sit down and give up are the ones who never get any closer to receiving the benefits that God has promised them.

So what if you come up against an obstacle or a problem? Think of all the men and women in the Bible who faced obstacles and problems. The Word of God tells us that our enemy goes about as a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour (1 Peter 5:8). The Word

Television shows and movies make alcohol and drugs look exciting. But ask the people—the former lawyers, doctors, CEOs, preachers, and so forth-who have chosen that path. They saw the glamour and the bright lights; that's the side the devil wants to show people. But go behind the scenes, and you'll find out that the path ends in destruction. Only

Jesus can bring life—and that more abundantly (John 10:10).

In Acts chapter 16, we read that Paul and Silas were in jail, up against their own "Jericho wall." Paul and Silas didn't panic; instead, they praised the Lord! Most people in that situation would have said, "Paul, you invited me to go on this missionary trip, and look where we are now. What's the matter here? We must be out of the will of God."

Sometimes, facing tremendous obstacles and circumstances simply proves that you are in the will of God. Who do you think the devil tries to mess with the most? Those who are in the will of God-the people Satan knows are going to tear his kingdom apart. What's the use of messing with someone who's not going to give him any problems?

So stay in the Jericho March. When your adversary attacks and you're facing every kind of obstacle imaginable, throw your hands in the air and (continued on page 7)

Wearing God's Fire Suit

The circumstances of life may bind you up and throw you into the fire, so to speak, but friend, you have a fire protection suit. It's the power and anointing of God!

Let me explain. I like car races, especially NASCAR. If you want to drive in a car race, you have to abide by the safety rules or you won't be allowed to enter the race. First. you have to wear a special kind of sock and undergarment. Then, you put a suit on top of that and put a hood on your head. Each of these garments is fire retardant. Race car drivers can be in a fiery crash and escape unburned because of these special suits.

However, the fire retardant suits race car drivers wear only hold up in a fire for a short period of time. They're designed to last long enough to allow the driver to be rescued. But the fire retardant suit that you and I have—the anointing and power of God-is a suit that lasts forever! No fiery dart of the enemy can penetrate it.

You're not going to go through life without having a problem, test, or trial. At some point, you are going to face the fire. But if you have strong faith in God and His Word, you will walk into the fire and out without being burned.

begin to praise God saying, "This is just another opportunity to prove that God is still God." You have the choice to succumb to defeat or to stay in the Jericho March.

Acts 16:25 says, "And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them." To me, the word "midnight" represents two things beyond the usual meaning of a specific time of day. Number one, it represents the darkest hour of a trial or circumstance. But midnight also represents the last part of the night, signaling that the day is just around the corner.

Someone going through a midnight trial might say, "Oh, it's so dark!"

I tell them, "That just means you need to look on the horizon because the S-o-n of God is beginning to shed His light on your pathway. And all your trials are going to melt like a snowball in the hot July Oklahoma sunshine."

... March on, and God will show you great and mighty things.


If the Israelites could shout and praise God when they only had the Ark of the Covenant to fix their eyes upon, how much more can we shout and praise God when the Presence of God is dwelling inside of us! But instead of shouting, too many people are sitting around, saying, "Why, God, why?" That's not what we should be saying. We should be shouting and praising God, saying, "I trust You, Lord. I believe Your Word."

Instead of looking for the answer to your question, "Why did this happen?" start looking for the victory. And keep marching. Too many people are asking, "Why?" when they should be marching. The sooner you start praising God and marching to His drumbeat, the sooner you're going to come out of your trial and situation.

March on, because just over the hill, the victory awaits you. Do not slow up when an obstacle is in the way. But march on through the heat and the cold, and God will show you the victory.

March on, and you shall see that what is behind you will have no affect on the future. The past is the past—it's over

and done with. Put it away forever and march on, and God will show you great and mighty things.



any Christians often do not know whether it is God or the devil doing things in their life. Some say, "Maybe the Lord is trying to teach me something." However, it is very easy to know the source of good and evil. James 1:17 says, "EVERY GOOD GIFT AND EVERY PERFECT GIFT IS FROM ABOVE, and cometh down from the Father of lights. . . ." And the Lord Jesus Himself contrasted His works with the works of the devil in John 10:10.

JOHN 10:10

10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

It is important to recognize that the source of whatever steals, kills, or destroys—the source of

our opposition—is Satan, and to stand our ground against him.

Too many Christians are ready to give up on what they're believing for instead of recognizing that it's Satan who is trying to keep their prayers from coming to pass. Many of the things we pray about finances, healing, and so forth-must come to pass in this earthly realm. And Satan is at work here in this natural realm. He will put up every roadblock he can to keep the blessing from happening. But whenever there is the least delay, some people say, "Maybe God doesn't want me to have such and such after all." Those people lose out and are defeated when they should have recognized that the source of their opposition is Satan and not allowed him to defeat them.

Ephesians chapter six makes it clear that it is Satan with whom we have to deal. Paul, writing this letter to the Church, plainly said, "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord..." (v. 10).

Someone may say, "Oh, I'm trying to be strong."

This verse does not say anything about trying to be strong or about being strong in ourselves. That's where people miss it. They drop back into the natural and try to do it themselves. This verse tells us to "be strong IN"

yourself, 'No, I am not going to have an attack.'"

We could always tell when one of those attacks was coming. Momma would start suffering from depression. She would begin thinking about hard, I'll lie on it." She made her bed hard and she tried to lie on it, but she just could not do it.

If you're not careful, you can start thinking about your past—mistakes you've made, where you've missed it—and get depressed. Then you can get into a spirit of depression. And that opens the door to the devil. You can get so perplexed, depressed, and oppressed that you do not know what you are doing, which direction you are going, or what your name is.

Back when my mom was being treated, we knew nothing about divine healing and praying, but Momma heeded this doctor's advice. She simply stood her ground. She refused to have any more attacks. A few times she would start to go into one of those periods of depression, but she would do what the doctor said. And never

THE LORD, and in the power OF HIS MIGHT."

Yes, there is a crafty foe pitted against us—but, thank God, we can stand victorious against him.

Someone might say, "I've done all I know to do. What am I to do now?"

Ephesians 6:13–14 says,"... having done all, to stand. Stand therefore...." When you've done all you know to do, just keep on standing!

My father left home when I was six. As a result of all the problems my father caused, my mother had a complete nervous and physical breakdown. So we went to live with our grandparents on my mother's side of the family.

When Granny had to do something, such as hanging the clothes outside to dry, she would have me watch Momma. Momma had "spells" where she would want to kill herself. I had to watch to see that she didn't get hold of a knife or something dangerous while my grandmother was busy.

Finally, Momma was sent to a Baptist hospital in Dallas to see the leading nerve specialist in the southwestern part of the country. After an examination, the doctor said that the chances of an operation correcting her blindness were not good. (Because of her mental and physical breakdown, Momma had become blind.)

"When it comes to nerves," that wise doctor advised her, "you can do more for yourself than anyone else can and more than any medication could do for you. The main thing to do is this: Talk to yourself. The Bible says in Ephesians 6:13 and 14, '. . . having done all, to stand. Stand therefore. . . .' When you feel these attacks coming on, say to

everything that had happened to her in life—all the mistakes she had made and all the ways she had missed it.

Her parents had not wanted her to marry my father. When Momma married him against her parents' wishes, she said, "If I make my bed

FAITH IN ACTION

Receiving What Is Yours

Since August 1934, I never prayed about one single thing for myself without receiving it. Not one time did God ever say, "No." Nor did He ever say, "Wait a while." It's been said that God always answers our prayers—sometimes with a "yes," sometimes with a "no," and sometimes with a "wait a while." All such reasoning is human reasoning and doesn't line up with what the Bible says.

John 15:7 says, "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."

What are the conditions of this verse?

First: Abide in Jesus.

This means you must be born again. Those who are born again are *in Christ*.

Second: His Words abide in you.

Find scriptures that cover what you are praying about. Read, think about,

and say those verses over and over until they are a part of you. That is how you get God's Word to abide—or live—in you.

Many times—even though I know the Scriptures, even though I can quote them—I do not pray about some things until I've gone back to the Word and reminded myself from the Word what God says on the subject. If it's not an emergency, instead of praying immediately, I go back to the Word. I go over those scriptures sometimes for a day or two before I pray.

Not only must we abide in Him, but His Word must abide in us.

Third: Ask what you will, and it shall be done unto you.

When God's Word abides in you, you don't have to worry about whether or not what you're praying is the will of God. *God's Word is His will*, and when you pray the Word, you're sure to pray out God's will for your life. That is how you know that what you ask in prayer shall be done (1 John 5:14–15).

again did she suffer one of the violent attacks where her mind was completely gone.

My mom stood her ground, and

against it. You do not have to yield to things that are from the devil. You can stand against them.

I am glad I got hold of these truths when I was just a young man. I have been following this practice in my If doubt persists in coming against my mind, I say, "Doubt, I resist you." I speak to it. I recognize that doubt comes from Satan, my enemy. By resisting the doubt, I am resisting Satan—the source of my opposition.

If fear comes—and I am tempted to be afraid just as much as anyone else—I speak to it. "Fear, I resist you."

I recognize fear and doubt as being evil. I do the same thing with sickness, lack, and any other attack of Satan.

If you want to walk in victory, recognize that the source of all opposition is Satan, and stand against him. Realize that we have authority over the devil because Jesus already defeated him for us. We can stand against the devil and be victorious through our Lord Jesus Christ!

Yes, there is a crafty foe pitted against us—but, thank God, we can stand victorious against him.

every symptom left. And for more than fifty years thereafter, she never had any mental problems whatsoever.

That doctor helped Momma see where the opposition was. He helped her understand that she could stand own life since even before I was filled with the Holy Spirit or knew anything about it. I stop wherever I am—in the middle of a room, the middle of a street, or wherever. If I am alone, I stand my ground out loud. If I am around people, I do so quietly.

'Someone Made a Really Big Mistake'

When a doctor says, "You could have a heart attack at any minute," the situation immediately turns serious. And those were the exact words Bill Steinmetz heard his doctor say after running

a Thallium Stress Test, a type of nuclear scanning test that is usually done along with an exercise test to show how well blood is flowing to the heart.

"I was about halfway through the treadmill test when the doctor stopped me and said he had enough information," Bill said. "A week later he called and said he wanted to schedule me for a heart

catheterization. When I asked 'Why?' he said, 'It's not a matter of your having a problem; it's a matter of how severe the problem is. You have blockage in your arteries and must have something done. You could have a heart attack at any minute."

Bill was told that he would have one of two procedures done depending on the results of the heart catheterization. He would either need open heart surgery or have stents inserted to increase blood flow to his heart. Little did he know that his wife was

> working on a third procedure.

Because his work schedule, Bill didn't have much free time, so his wife, Shirley, went to Prayer and Healing School on the RHEMA campus in Broken Arrow. Oklahoma. She took a washcloth with her to Healing School, asking for hands to be laid on it for Bill to receive his healing. She put

the prayer cloth in Bill's pillowcase.

"I didn't even know it was in there," Bill said. But the power of God was working through that cloth.

When Bill had his heart catheterization, the results surprised the medical staff. Bill recalled, "The doctor came out and told my wife, 'Someone made a really big mistake. I couldn't find

anything wrong with your husband. He has the heart of a twenty year old."

Shirley knew God had intervened. She said, "It was no mistake. Bill got a miracle."

Before the doctor told Bill the results, Shirley went to his room and talked to him. That was when she revealed to Bill that she had hidden a prayer cloth in his pillow case.

"When the doctor came in to tell me the results, it was worth it just to see the look on his face," Bill said. "He told me, 'Someone made a really big mistake.' I asked him if he had talked to my wife, and he said he had. I told him, 'No one made a mistake. The doctors saw what they saw, and I got a miracle.' The doctor just shook his head and walked out of the room."

When Bill returned to see the doctor who had originally diagnosed the problem and suggested the heart catheterization, the doctor confirmed that Bill had received a miracle. He wrote, "Mr. Steinmetz had an abnormal stress test showing potential blockage to his heart. The following heart catheterization was totally normal!"

Stick With the Word!

don't know where I would be without the Word of God. When trials, tests, and tribulations come, I am always able to go to the Word and find answers. God's Word has kept me throughout my life.

As we begin a new year, the most important advice I could give anyone is this: Stick with the Word of God during the upcoming year. For it is only through the Word that you will have the abundant life that Jesus desires you to have.

The way to stand firm and not waver during tests or trials is to have the Word of God as a solid foundation in our lives. This is done by reading and meditating on Scripture every day.

When Joshua was preparing to lead the children of Israel into the Promised Land, God admonished him to constantly read and study the Word. If Joshua would do this, he was guaranteed success.

JOSHUA 1:8

8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

Meditating on the Word every day involves more than reading the shortest Psalm in the Bible and believing we have done our spiritual duty for the day. We must take time to really read the Word of God and allow it to soak into our spirit man.

Maybe you feel as though you don't have time to read and study God's Word. I know how you feel. We're all so busy in today's world. But let me ask you a few questions.

Do you have time to read the newspaper? Do you make time to watch your favorite TV show? What about your other recreational pastimes? Do you find time for them? Although these activities aren't necessarily bad, none of them compare to the importance of reading and meditating on God's Word.

The Word is what gives you the strength to do the things the Lord has called you to do. And it's through the Word of God that you are able to overcome the attacks of the evil one.

The Apostle Peter tells us to "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour" (1 Peter 5:8). Of one thing in life we can be sure: the attacks of the enemy will come. But if we determine in our heart to stand firmly on the Word and never budge from it, we won't be devoured.

It takes toughness to stand in faith against the schemes of the devil. And sometimes we have to stand a while before we will see our situations turn around. That's when we have to choose whose report we will believe—will we believe our situation and what the devil has thrown at us, or what the Lord says?

I made up my mind a long time ago. I will always believe the report of the Lord.

The old Pentecostals used to sing the classic gospel hymn I'm Going Through. I particularly like part of the refrain, which says:

I'm going through, I'm going through, I'll pay the price, Whatever others do. 1

We need to have the attitude that

no matter what adversity comes our way, we are going through. When our mind is made up like that, we will receive everything the Lord has for us.

Many times, we fall short of the blessings of God because we won't press in and stand for what rightfully belongs to us. What would have happened to the woman who had an issue of blood if she hadn't heard the Word of God (Mark 5)? What if she

hadn't heard the news that Jesus went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed of the devil (Acts 10:38)?

In the natural, there was no hope for this woman. She had spent all of her money going to doctors who desperately tried to help her. But her condition was beyond their medical knowledge. The doctors' report did not give this woman any hope of being cured. But instead of believing the doctors' verdict, she chose to believe what she had heard about Jesus.

I'm sure this woman must have been fearful and trembling when she came

upon the crowd surrounding Jesus. According to Jewish law, she was not supposed to be in public. Her infirmity made her unclean.

The crowd that day was huge, and she must have been weak from the loss of blood. It was probably difficult for her to push her way through the people to get to Jesus. What if she had turned away? What if she had said to herself, This is too

> hard; I'll never make it? What if she had given up and turned back?

> We know from the Word that this woman didn't turn back; she pressed through the crowd. And when she touched the hem of Jesus' garment, she felt God's healing power make her body whole.

> Can you see how important it is for us to keep on pressing in until we receive the answers

God has promised us in His Word? Can you see how vital it is for us to stand firm on that foundation? In today's world, with all the distractions that surround us, it's more important than ever for us to stick with God's Word. When we stick with God's Word, God's Word will see us through—no matter what!

Here's an acrostic using the word stick to help remind you to stick with the Word!


S: Search the Scriptures Daily. Read God's Word each day. Then you will have a strong foundation when the inevitable storms of life come your way.

"I will never forget the man who came to Healing School who had a tumor on his foot," said Emmett Anderson, a RHEMA Healing School technician. "His foot was so swollen he couldn't wear a shoe, and the pressure from the swelling had broken five bones in his foot. When we prayed for him, the tumor dried up. Afterwards he went in for x-rays, and doctors couldn't find a fracture in his foot—anywhere."

This is just one of many miraculous testimonies that occur on a weekly basis at RHEMA's Healing School. And



it's exactly what the healing technicians expect. Of course, when you've seen hundreds of people healed of cancer, it's hard *not* to expect people to be healed.

"The first thing I would tell people if they were planning on coming to Healing School is that they can expect to get healed," said Emmett, who has been a healing technician since 2000. "It wouldn't be Healing School if people didn't get healed. We believe that everyone who walks through the doors will be healed."

Even though the healing technicians are expecting people to be healed, it's even easier for the people to be healed when the people themselves come expecting. Candas

Jackson, a healing technician for eight years, and granddaughter of Rev. Kenneth E. Hagin, said, "The people that read about Healing School in The Word of Faith are the easiest to get healed because they are expecting to be healed."

Candas has seen tumors shrink before her very eyes. One woman came to Healing School because she had tumors that prevented her from becoming pregnant. After the lady listened to teaching throughout the week, Candas prayed for her and watched as the tumors disappeared immediately.

The people who attend Healing School don't just get healed; they stay healed because of what they are taught. People can receive healing in a prayer line at a regular church service, but many times they aren't taught how to retain the healing. One session at Healing School is devoted to teaching on how to keep your healing.

"We teach people how to receive healing on their own," Emmett explained. "They can get it on their own faith, and they can keep it on their own faith. We have great success with people keeping their healing because we teach them how to do it. You can't do that in a healing line at church; there's not enough time to teach on it. People from out of town usually come to Healing School for at least a week, so it gives us a whole week to minister to them and teach them."

Some of the healings are not instantaneous. On the outside it sometimes appears as if nothing has changed, but that doesn't mean the healing power of God isn't at work in that person's body.

"We had a little boy whose parents brought him from the Carolinas," Emmett said. "He had a disease where he couldn't control his muscles. We prayed for him for five days. We never saw any change, but we knew God's healing anointing went into him. About six months after they left, his mother called and said the boy was crawling, and after nine months, he was completely healed."

When people receive results like that, it thrills the staff and healing technicians at Healing School. They know there is no sickness, disease, or infirmity too big for God.

"It's fulfilling," Candas said. "I love seeing people healed. Healing School is the best kept secret in Broken Arrow. People come here, get healed, and say, 'Why don't people know about this?' "

Emmett agreed.

"There is no place on earth like Healing School at RHEMA," he said. "We have a minister from Tulsa who comes to Healing School. He was diagnosed with congestive heart failure. When he first started coming, he couldn't walk into the building from his car, and now he runs six miles a day. He told us, 'I've been all around the world preaching, but I've never been around the Word of God the way I am when I'm here.'


