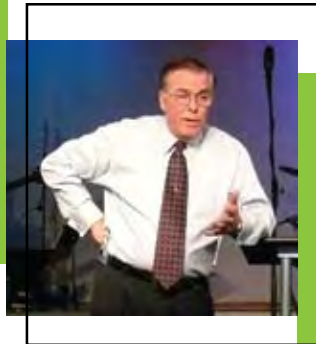

A New and Living Way



Heart to Heart

With Kenneth W. Hagin

We are living in a new day—a day when we can boldly go into the Presence of God, a day when we no longer have to be dominated by sin, sickness, or lack. The writer of Hebrews talked about this day, saying, “Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, His body” (Heb. 10:19–20 NIV).

I am so thankful for what Jesus did on the Cross for us. When He said, “It is finished” (John 19:30), the curtain in the Temple split from top to bottom. This was God’s way of declaring that His Presence would no longer dwell behind a curtain or in a house built of stone. Now, God would dwell in the hearts of mankind.

As Hebrews 10 continues, we are instructed to do five things: “LET US DRAW NEAR to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith . . . LET US HOLD unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And LET US CONSIDER how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. LET US NOT GIVE UP meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but LET US ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER—and all the more as you see the Day approaching” (vv. 22–25 NIV).

These verses indicate that decisions are required of us. You see, we—and not God—decide what our lifestyle and priorities will be. God will not force us to do anything. If we choose not to draw near to Him, He won’t do anything about it. We are the ones who determine whether our lifestyle pleases God.

When we are told in Hebrews 10:23 to “. . . hold unswervingly to the hope we profess,” we have a choice to make. Are we going to daily confess what the Word of God says about us and see that Word come to pass in our lives, or are we going to keep our mouth shut and in doing so, allow the devil to run over us?

Our fight against the devil is not a physical fight. We can’t roll up our shirt sleeves and slug it out with him. But we can hit him squarely between the eyes when we speak the Word of God. And when it looks

like our circumstances are not changing, we can make the commitment to unswervingly hold on to the hope we profess. We can confidently stand on the Word of God, knowing that victory is on its way.

Next, we are encouraged to “. . . spur one another on toward love and good deeds” (v. 24). In other words, we must decide whether we are going to walk the love walk and minister to the needs of others. Talk is cheap. It’s easy to quote Scripture and tell someone that God will supply his or her needs. But it’s another thing to give that individual money for groceries. Let’s make a commitment to do “good deeds” to others.

The writer of Hebrews also knew the importance of going to church. He was aware that some Christians in the early Church were in the habit of not meeting together. And he warned against doing this. You see, when you come together with people of like faith, you are strengthened, especially in hard times. And having regular fellowship with people of like faith enables you to stand strong in your own faith even when you feel like quitting.

There is something therapeutic about getting together with people who believe the same way you do. Over the years, I’ve often heard people say, “I feel closer to my church family than I do my natural family.” But if you stay away from your spiritual family, you’ll never reap the benefits that come through fellowship.

As we walk in this new and living way and draw close to God, let us never let go of the Word of God, for it is our life and strength. Let us purpose to do all that we are instructed to do in Hebrews 10, and let us not forget to reach out to our brothers and sisters in the Lord, encouraging them to stand strong in their faith.

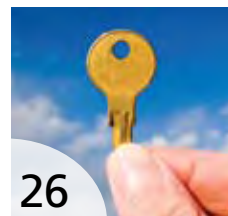

Making Your **DREAMS** Come True

(Editor's Note: This article was adapted from the book How to Make the Dream God Gave You Come True.)

For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

—Habakkuk 2:3

God has spoken to each of us at some time in our life. He's given us dreams—He's given us visions—and He's given us things to accomplish for Him. Now we are either actively involved with God's dream for us, we are letting it lie dormant, or we are somewhere in the middle—luke-warm—working with it sometimes and sometimes not.

I want to inspire you to get a new hold on your dream. Pull it

off the shelf, dust it off, and get on with it.

You might feel trapped in failure, distress, or sickness. You must begin to dream in line with God's Word. You must see yourself as a success. You must see yourself healed. You must see yourself as more than a conqueror in Christ Jesus. You must see yourself greater than the circumstances around you, for ". . . *greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world*" (1 John 4:4).

Dare to dream big dreams for God! Purpose in your heart that the dream God has given to you will not lie dormant, and that you will do something about it. You *will* accomplish it. You *will* succeed for Him.

No, I am not talking about everyone rushing out and starting to travel, teach, and preach all over the world. I am talking about doing what God has asked you to

do in your own backyard—in your local church or fellowship—and then going on from that point. Fulfill the dream that God has put in *your* heart.

Many people say, “In this highly technological and educated age, I can’t do anything. I know God spoke to me, but I just do not see how it is possible to fulfill *my* dream.”

But let’s consider the life of Joseph. When he was trapped in that pit, waiting until his brothers sold him as a slave, he probably said to himself, *My Lord God, what is happening? This is NOT the way my dream was supposed to turn out!*

And later, when Joseph found himself working as a servant in Egypt, I’m sure he had many opportunities to say, “Wait a minute, God. You are making a mistake! Here I am a *servant*, but I’m supposed to be a *leader*. I’m supposed to be the one everybody bows down to!”

And when Joseph was thrown into

Yes, you have an enemy who can make your God-given dream seem so blurry that you can hardly see it. But dare to dream your dream. When it seems the devil has shattered your dream, reach down by God’s grace, pick up those shattered pieces, and allow God to put the dream back together.

A dream becomes a reality because someone wants it to become a reality. It becomes a reality because someone dares to believe it can be. And those believers set out to make their dream come true.

We don’t have electric lights today just because a man was walking along and stubbed his toe. No, we have working lights because a man said, “Electricity is a real substance. I believe I can harness it for the good of mankind.” Thomas Edison set out to do the job, and he invented the first practical electric light bulb.

Don’t Quit!

Let’s face it, at some time or another, we will be confronted with challenging obstacles. We must realize that it’s not our own strength that will put us over. Holding on to God’s Word in trying circumstances and difficult situations is the only way to be successful in life.

No matter what you’re facing, quitting on the plan God has for you will profit nothing, but wholeheartedly following God’s plan will win you everything.

Here are some keys to help you stand when everything around you seems to be falling apart:

1. Keep looking to God instead of looking at the problem. Focus on His Word instead of feelings.
2. Just take one step at a time in faith, believing that God is faithful to keep His promise.
3. Keep a thankful attitude and stay committed to God.
4. Voice your desires to God and go boldly to the throne of grace to obtain mercy to help in your time of need.
5. Refuse to settle for second best. God has made you more than a conqueror!

Defeat isn’t part of Jesus’ nature, and it should not be part of your nature either. Because of Calvary, no problem is unsolvable and no fear is unconquerable.

Resolve to renew your commitment to God and go after the dream He has given you. Put away thoughts and feelings of failure and hopelessness. When you dare to believe God, you’ll walk in victory as you achieve your dream.

prison on false charges, his dream could have been shattered. But he kept believing God. Joseph did not understand *how* his dream would come to pass, but he remained true to the Lord—even when he was a prisoner in a foreign land.

Joseph’s dream could have become very distant in that Egyptian dungeon. But he held on to God’s promise. And approximately 13 years after he entered Egypt as a slave, Joseph stood in Egypt as prime minister, controlling the nation’s storehouses in a time of famine.

Joseph’s dream turned out exactly the way God had said—but it was not an easy process. At any point during those long years, Joseph could have decided to quit, and the dream would have gone down with him. God would have had to look around for someone else to fulfill what He wanted done.

God has given many people dreams and visions to accomplish for Him. The sad fact is that many have quit when they reached a hard place, and their

son’s dream was destroyed hundreds of times. Every time Thomas Edison failed and started to give up, something deep inside him said, *There is a substance—there is a material—that can work with electricity and give illumination, and the results will benefit mankind.*

Edison did not let go of his dream no matter how many times it was shattered. Because he kept dreaming that dream, you and I enjoy the advantages of the electric light bulb.

There was another man who dreamed a dream and would not let it go.

Watching the 1968 Olympics (held in Mexico City), I saw a young American runner come off the last corner of the last event in the decathlon championship. And as the television cameras zeroed in on him, I could almost feel the agony etched in his face.

Bill Toomey had overcome every kind of adversity to get to that point. He had long dreamed of winning the decathlon, which consists of ten track-and-field events held over a two-day period.

As he lined up for the one-mile race, his body was saying, "You can't do it. You can't run anymore. You've had it!"

When the TV cameras zoomed in on him, I could see the agony in every muscle in his body as he came down that last hundred or so yards toward the final tape. His muscles began to tense. Recognizing the Source of OPPOSITION

(Editor's Note: This article was adapted from the book *What to Do When Faith Seems Weak and Victory Lost.*)

So many times people do not know whether God or the devil is doing a particular thing. "Well," they say, "maybe the Lord is trying to teach me something."

I remember hearing a certain evangelist years ago. He had a tent that seated 20,000 people. But when he put it up in Texas, one of those Texas tornadoes came along and blew it away. At a meeting I attended, they were taking up a special offering to help him get another tent. And I almost fell off my seat when I heard him say, "I don't know whether God or the devil blew away my tent."

God is not out blowing down preachers' tents! God is out putting them up!

"Yes," someone may say, "but God *allowed* it."

God is not the god of this world. Second Corinthians 4:4 calls *Satan* the god of this world. And the laws governing the earth today very largely came into being with the fall of man and the resulting curse upon the earth.

It is because people do not understand these truths that they accuse God of causing accidents, sickness, the death of loved ones, storms, catastrophes, earthquakes, and floods. God is not responsible for, nor the author of, any one of those things.

Jesus set aside natural laws, as we understand them, in order to *bless* humanity. Jesus stood on board a ship and rebuked a storm, saying, "Peace, Be Still." According to John 14:10, it was God in Jesus who did the work. If God caused the storm, God would be working against Himself in causing it to cease.

JOHN 14:10

10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

It was the same with the healings Jesus performed. Jesus said, “The Father in me, He doeth the works.” All the healings, all the miracles, and all the mighty works that Jesus did, *God did*. If God were the author of sickness and disease, and God healed people through Jesus, then God worked against Himself.

It cannot be that God would work against Himself. For Jesus said, “*If a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand*” (Mark 3:24–25).

It is very easy to find out where things come from. The Lord Jesus Christ Himself contrasted His works with the works of the devil in John 10:10.

JOHN 10:10

10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

In contrasting His works with the works of the devil, Jesus is contrasting God’s works with the works of the devil. For on one occasion Jesus said, “*I must work the works of him [God the Father] that sent me while it is day: the night cometh when no man can work*” (John 9:4). On another occasion when one disciple said to Him, “*Show us the Father,*” Jesus answered, “*He that hath seen me hath seen the Father . . . the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works*” (John 14:9–10). If you want to see God at work, look at Jesus.

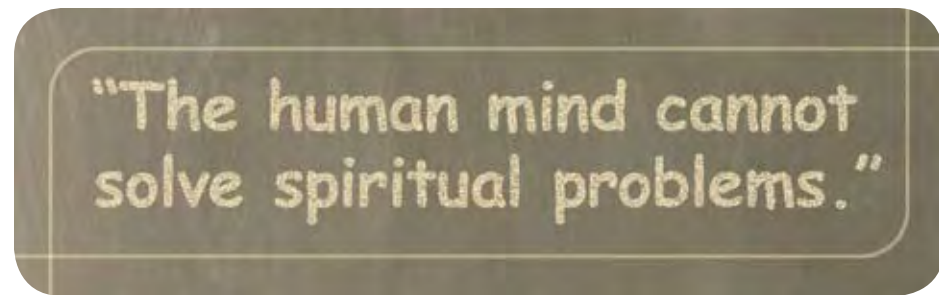
It would absolutely erase all confusion as to where a thing is coming from if we would read the Word of God.

Most of us, however, were conditioned by religious thinking from the time we were children—before we could read and understand the Word of God for ourselves. We have heard unscriptural things said all our lives—and sometimes even preached in the churches we’ve attended. What we heard was just the human mind trying to solve spiritual problems. And the human mind cannot solve spiritual problems.

If you will get into the Word of God, it will straighten out your thinking. Think in line with what God’s Word says—not necessarily with what you have been taught it says, nor with what someone told you it says. Ask yourself, “What does the Word of God say?”

Let’s examine what Jesus said in contrasting His works with the works of the devil.

Jesus said, “*The thief. . .*” He’s not calling God a thief. God is not a thief.



Jesus is not a thief. The devil is. Jesus calls the devil a thief.

Jesus said, “*The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. . .*” That which steals, that which kills, that which destroys comes from the thief. All such is the devil’s work—not God’s.

The Bible tells us that when Satan is finally eliminated from the earth, there will be nothing that hurts or destroys.

That will be a great day. But we do not have to let Satan dominate us in the here and now. Even though he is

the god of this world, Satan does not have the right to dominate the Church. He does not have the right to dominate us as believers.

It is important to recognize that the source of the opposition is Satan—and to stand your ground.

Too many people are ready to give up on something instead of recognizing that it is Satan who is trying to keep it from happening. Many of the things we pray about—finances, healing, and

so forth—have to come to pass in this world realm. And Satan is at work here. He will put up every roadblock he can to keep it from happening. Then if there is the least delay, some people say, “Maybe God doesn’t want me to have that after all.” They lose out and are defeated when they should have recognized that the source of all opposition is Satan. They should not have allowed him to defeat them.

The Apostle Paul plainly said, “*Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord . . .*” (Eph. 6:10).

FAITH IN ACTION

Standing Firm on God’s Word

The moment you wonder why God has not answered you, the moment you look around for some reason why He did not hear your prayer, or the moment you begin to accept the delay in the answer as a sign that God did not want you to have what you prayed, you are defeated.

If God promises you something in His Word, or His Word tells you something belongs to you, *He intends for you to have it!* If God does not intend for you to have what His Word promises, then He is fooling you, and He is a partner to trickery. But God is *not* a partner to trickery. He does not lie.

Regarding spiritual things, if people would just take a stand for what belongs to them like they do in the natural, it would solve a lot of difficulties. God’s Word is a legal document. The New Testament is the will of God for us. God intends for us to have everything His Word says is ours. We should never lie down and play dead, so to speak, giving in to the devil.

If the Word of God promises you the things you are praying about, God is not going to suddenly change and say, “No, you can’t have it.” So stand firm on God’s Word and believe that you will see the answers to your Bible-based prayers.

Someone may say, "Oh, I'm trying to be strong."

The Bible does not say a thing in the world about our being strong. That's where people miss it. They drop back into the natural and try to do it themselves. The Bible does not say, "Be strong in yourself." No, we're told to "be strong *IN THE LORD, and in the power of HIS MIGHT.*"

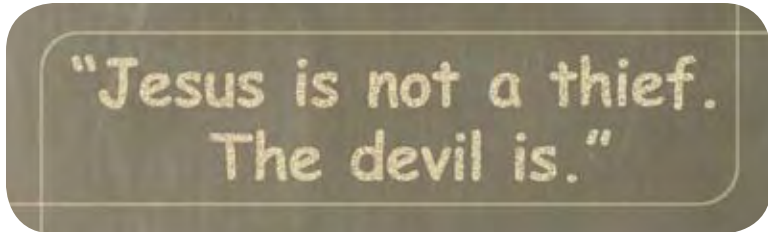
We used to hear people say in testimony meetings, "Pray for me that I will hold out faithfully to the end." Bless their hearts, they were just trying to "hold on and hold out." And they didn't know whether they could or couldn't.

I use this illustration quite often. On May 11, 1932, a crowd of 10,000 assembled to welcome the world's largest dirigible, the U.S. Navy's \$8 million USS *Akron*, to Camp Kearney, San Diego, California. (At that time, the U.S. government was experimenting with lighter-than-air craft.)

The mooring appeared to be successful. Then a ring that held one of the two mooring cables snapped and the 785-foot airship started to lift. Two groups of sailors holding landing ropes attached to the cables attempted to guide the *Akron* back to its mooring mast, but

strong winds buffeted the giant dirigible, and it broke loose, lifting many of the 200 sailors 10-20 feet off the ground. Some were injured as they fell. Then only three men dangled from the 300-foot cable as the *Akron* continued to ascend.

According to contemporary newspaper accounts, hysteria prevailed. Women fainted. Officers wept. Enlisted men ran around wildly, unable to help the three desperate men clinging to



the cable. Soon, two of the men could hold on no longer, and they plummeted 150–200 feet to their deaths.

Farther up in the twisted lines, the third sailor, a 19-year-old enlisted man from Oklahoma, braced his feet in some wooden handgrips and quickly lashed other lines attached to the cable around his body. He just kept holding on as the *Akron* rose to 2,000 feet. The horrified onlookers thought his strength would fail at any moment and he, too, would fall to his death. Half an hour passed.

Then the tiny figure moved—the man was alive!

Attempts to lower the giant aircraft were unsuccessful because of the winds. The sailor's two-hour ordeal finally ended when the crew cautiously hauled him inside the airship by hand while the *Akron* circled San Diego.

When people asked him, "How did you hold on so long," he replied, "I didn't hold on. When I saw I was too far from the ground to let go, I wrapped the ropes around me. I wasn't holding onto them; they were holding me."

While people on the ground were screaming, he was up there enjoying the scenery. He wasn't trusting in himself to hold on. He was trusting in the rope to hold him. He was swinging free!

That's what God's Word is talking about. "*Be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.*" If you try to hold on or stand against the devil in your own strength, you will tire out after a while. Yes, there is a wily foe opposing you, but thank God, you can be victorious against him. Just wrap yourself in the promises of God and swing free. ♠

Take the Gospel to the Nations

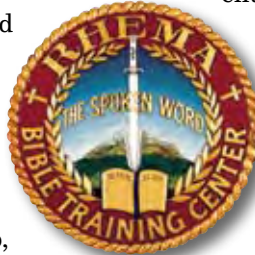
The excitement in the Tulsa convention center on May 9, 2008, was tangible as 473 students surrounded by their friends and families stood ready to graduate from RHEMA Bible Training Center USA. Their directive was clear: *Serve the Lord with a heart wholly committed to fulfilling His divine calling.*

Students who had completed second- and third-year programs were formally charged to take their God-ordained places as pastors, teachers, evangelists, missionaries, and supportive ministers serving in vital roles in local churches.

RHEMA's first graduation ceremony in 1975 recognized 58 students who had completed studies. Since that year, more than 25,000 graduates have been trained to take the Gospel of Christ and the message of faith to the ends of the earth.

This year's graduates hailed from the United States, Australia, Cameroon, Canada, France, Germany, the Netherlands, and South Africa. They were greeted by applause and cheers from family members, friends, pastors, and fellow believers as they filed into the arena during the processional.

The graduates each wore an identifying cap, gown, and stole and together formed a stunning sea of color. Second-year students marched down the red carpet dressed in a red cap and gown with a white stole. Third-year graduates followed wearing either royal blue with a gold stole, teal green with a grey stole, gold with a purple stole, or black with a red stole—their colors signifying General Extended Studies, the RHEMA School of



Worship, the RHEMA School of World Missions, and the RHEMA School of Pastoral Ministries respectively.

After a time of praise and worship, Kenneth W. Hagin, president of RHEMA Bible Training Center, greeted the graduates, telling them that the ceremony marked their entrance into a new world.

“You now have a responsibility to God and to yourself to make sure that you carry out the vision and plan that you had within you when you started RHEMA Bible Training Center two or three years ago,” said Rev. Hagin, who formed RBTC in 1974. “When you walk out those doors tonight, you walk into a new world that is waiting for you to serve, to help, to heal, and to save. There are many needs, and you have been trained to fill those needs. Go and do what God has asked you to do—what you have been trained to do.”

Tony Cooke, a 1981 RHEMA graduate, was the commencement speaker for this year's ceremony. In his address, Rev. Cooke challenged the graduates to carry out God's plan with their eyes steadfastly focused on serving the Lord and valuing those things He considers most important.

“Tonight is not your destination, but a launching pad,” said Rev. Cooke, known to many present as a former RHEMA dean and instructor, associate pastor of RHEMA Bible Church, and director of RHEMA Ministerial Association International and RHEMA Alumni Association.

Rev. Cooke went on to exhort the graduates, saying, “Although some of you may have a clear view of your calling and others may not, *all of you* have roles to fill and should be committed to making things happen for the Kingdom of God.

“For those of you who don't know exactly what you're supposed to do, find someone else who has a clear, compelling purpose and vision—a purpose that you can embrace and believe in—and help that person fulfill their purpose,” said





By using an acrostic that spells the word *charge*, Tony Cooke exhorted RHEMA graduates to remain faithful to God and to His call on their lives:

C—Continue

God didn't call you to simply be a good starter. God called you to be a strong finisher. Never, never, never quit in your pursuit of God. Never quit learning. Never quit growing. Never quit developing yourself.

H—Hustle

If it's worth doing, it's worth doing right. It's worth giving 110 percent. Whatever you do, do it with all your heart.

A—Adapt

Learn to be flexible. Life is going to throw curve balls at you. There's going to be all kinds of unexpected developments. Learn to adapt. Remember this: Blessed are the flexible, because they will not get bent out of shape.

R—Resilient

You are going to take some hits and experience some disappointments along the way. If you don't already know it, understand that ministry is a contact sport. If you learn how to bounce, you will never truly crash.

G—Grace

Remember your Source. You are what you are by the grace of God. When great things happen—and they will—remember to give God all the glory, because He's your Source. And always remember to hold in highest respect and admiration those through whom the grace of God came to you. You are light years ahead of where you would have been if you had not come to this place.

E—Exalt

Always give God glory for everything that is accomplished and determine that He will receive much glory from your life.

Rev. Cooke, whose worldwide ministry focuses on strengthening churches and leaders.

“Working in a supportive role is as high a calling as any in the Body of Christ,” Rev. Cooke said, recalling how he and his wife, Lisa, began in ministry by serving as janitors in a local church.

When Rev. Cooke began to devalue the position, the Lord told him: “I want you to treat this job as though it were your ultimate calling and the most important thing you will ever do for Me.”

While some people may seek positions or titles, God desires believers whose primary motivation is to serve without focusing on status or admiration from others, Rev. Cooke explained. He then cautioned graduates to avoid comparing themselves to others and falling into the trap of viewing their



contributions as less significant than the contributions of others.

Many have made major contributions to the Body of Christ and society by using the seemingly small things they possessed, he said. David used a small sling to bring down a giant. Samson used a jawbone to kill thousands. Peter had one boat, but from it Jesus preached to a multitude.

“In every one of these circumstances, the person used what he had—even though it may have seemed insignificant. Give God something to work with—act, serve, work, labor,” Rev. Cooke said.

He added that spiritual victory and social progress always come through those who don't limit themselves. “The world is a better place because Mary didn't say, ‘I don't do virgin births.’ The world is a better place because Jesus didn't say, ‘I don't do crosses.’”

Rev. Cooke concluded, “I don't know exactly which way your path will lead. . . . But I pray that each of you will possess an attitude that is eager to serve God

with all of your heart, and you won't sit passively by waiting for some ‘big thing’ while ignoring the multitude of opportunities that surround you every day.”

Prior to the official presentation of the class of 2008, Marvin Yoder, presiding over the graduation ceremony for the last time as RHEMA's current dean, explained the significance of the red batons that Kenneth and Lynette Hagin presented to each graduate who walked across the stage. The baton was inspired from a message Kenneth W. Hagin preached at a new-student orientation in which he challenged the men and women to take revival to their generation.

An inscription on the baton reads: “I commit today to carry the baton of revival to this generation. I will carry the banner of faith in God's power to a lost and dying world. This is my time to do all that God has called me to do.”

Rev. Hagin charged graduates from various passages in the Word of God, reminding them to be faithful, steadfast, obedient, and compassionate in carrying out God's plan for their life and ministry.

In his benediction, Craig W. Hagin asked God to empower graduates to touch a lost and dying world with the knowledge of the Truth, using the skills they had gained during their time at RHEMA. He asked God to grant the students a spirit of perseverance which echoes in Kenneth W. Hagin's personal motto: “I cannot be defeated, and I will not quit!”

The arena lights were dimmed during the singing of the RHEMA alma mater as students held up small faux candles symbolizing their willingness to carry the flame of truth to the world. Students held the candles high as they exited the arena during the recessional, equipped and ready to take the Gospel to the nations. ♠

Do What the Word Says, Because the Word Works

Moving to a new area where you don't know anyone can be difficult. Starting a church in an area where you don't know anyone can be even more difficult—unless God called you to do just that.

“We started with nothing, and I didn't know anyone in the city,” said John White, a 1983 graduate of RHEMA Bible Training Center and founding pastor of Decatur Christian Fellowship in Decatur, Alabama. “But God has blessed us. It's been one adventure after another.”

A few months after graduating from RBTC, John found himself preaching in an unusual place. “Our first meeting was in city hall in the courtroom,” he said laughing. “That was a miracle in itself. They let us use it for one service.”

Approximately 20 people attended that first service, and 25 years and four buildings later, 400 to 500 people now attend on Sunday mornings. Along the way, John gave away his entire building fund.

John explained that he was led to give the building fund away, saying, “The Lord told me to give the money away, so I gave \$2,000 to another church's building program and \$1,000 to help pay a student's tuition at RBTC. Six months later we had \$220,000 in our building program, plus a full-time paid staff of six people.”

The church now owns two buildings and \$6 million worth of land, and it's being used for the Lord's work—seeing many people saved and healed. “If you'll apply the Word that you're taught, the Word always works,” John said.

And the Word is exactly what people should expect to hear when they attend Decatur Christian Fellowship. “You'll be taught how to receive the promises that God has given us through the sacrifice of the Lord Jesus Christ,” John said. “You'll be taught how to use your faith to obtain those things. We have great praise and worship, but our main emphasis is on teaching the Word of God.”



Taste and See That the Lord Is Good

At the age of 23, David Gray accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior and was set free—in the spiritual sense. Little did he know that just four years after praying that salvation prayer in his small jail cell, he would also be physically free and pastoring a church!

Upon his release and after completing his first year at RHEMA in 1982, David returned to Ridgely, Tennessee, where he became actively involved in helps ministry at Abundant Life Fellowship Church. He worked with children, youth, music, and prison ministry.

David tells the story: “When I was in school, I heard Brother Hagin say, ‘Whatever your hand finds to do, do it and get involved with the local church.’ That's

basically what I did when I moved back home. I tried to be a blessing to my church. I didn't know I was going to be a pastor."

But that's exactly what happened a short two years later. In 1986, David became the pastor of Abundant Life Fellowship Church. And the church has since grown from a congregation of 15 to a congregation of 150.

David's congregation hears the Word taught and sees it in operation. When a particular couple in the church was expecting a child, their doctor noticed a mass and told them they could lose their baby. So David prayed for them.

"When they went back a few weeks later, the mass was gone," David said. "The doctor said, 'A mass does not *dissolve* like this.' He used that particular word, not knowing that we had previously prayed and said, 'We speak to this mass to *dissolve* in the Name of Jesus.' The woman carried the baby full term and has two children now."

And visitors should expect to hear the Word as well.

"You'll be welcome and you'll experience the love of God," David said. "You'll hear the Word of God taught with simplicity and you'll experience the Presence of God in our church services. You'll taste and see that the Lord is good."

Pastoring Generations for God

Late-night phone calls. Hospital visits. Conducting funerals. The life of a pastor isn't always easy. But it does have its rewards.

"It's been fun seeing the 'hard cases' get saved," said Mark Bintliff, pastor of New Creation Church in Glenwood Springs, Colorado. Church members have told him of people in their lives who would never get saved. But a year later that person is saved and serving God.

Mark says those cases are notable, but the thing he loves the most is ministering to generations of families. He has been at the church for 26 years, including 16 years as pastor. He's watched kids born to church members grow up in church serving God, and then he's performed their weddings and dedicated their children. "I've been here long enough to see a generation go through. To me, that's amazing. I love it."

After graduating from RHEMA Bible Training Center in 1982, Mark moved to Glenwood Springs and immediately got involved at a new church. He did everything from work with the youth to helping in the office. After 10 years of faithful service, Mark was asked to be the pastor when the founding pastor moved.

Since then the church has flourished, growing from a congregation of 70 to a congregation of 450 in 16 years. Mark attributes the growth to consistency.

"Our growth comes from staying consistent with the Word, the Spirit, and the vision that God gave us," he said. "We've made some changes, but we've built a staff that stays consistent with our vision."

And with the growth of the congregation, the church itself has grown as well. The church's new facility was completed in January 2003. "When we paid off our building it was miraculous," Mark said. "We weren't taking up a special offering or anything, and we had \$320,000 come in on a Sunday morning"

According to Mark, one of his highlights in ministry was hosting Revs. Kenneth and Lynette Hagin at his church for an *All Faiths' Crusade* in August 2007.



A Multiracial Church in a Multiracial World

The e-mail said, "My wife and I attended your church for the first time today and thoroughly enjoyed our experience. It's obvious that the Holy Spirit is at work in your church, and thank you for making us feel welcome."

Denny Beavers, a 1990 graduate of RHEMA Bible Training Center and pastor of Living Word Church in Jonesboro, Arkansas, is blessed by such reports and shares them as a testimony to what God is doing at Living Word Church. Denny's church has grown from 40 to 250 in 12 years because of the loving atmosphere in his church.

"Our church has grown by our being steady and faithful, but more than anything, by our letting the people know how much we love and care for them," Denny said. "When you visit, you'll find a very loving, multiracial church family where you can feel the presence of the Holy Spirit in a strife-free atmosphere. You will feel welcomed and loved and hear the uncompromised Word of God."

When Denny became pastor in 1996, one of his goals was to have a diverse membership in his church, something lacking in many churches today.

"Prior to our coming here, there were no multiracial churches in Jonesboro," Denny explained. "It was our goal to develop a multiracial church family. Now we are nearly 50 percent African-American and 50 percent Caucasian in our membership. Our next goal is to reach the Hispanic community."

Denny, who is also the District Director for RHEMA in Arkansas, has watched God move greatly in people's lives. He told the story of a woman who visited his church and got saved and filled with the Holy Spirit. Her ex-husband, upon his release from jail, also visited the church and got saved. The couple eventually remarried and are currently helping another RHEMA graduate start a church.

"It's a great testimony, showing that God is able to put families back together if people will commit themselves to Him," Denny said.

furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation” (Amplified).

You may be thinking, *Well, brother, you haven't been to my house. If you had, you'd know that I don't have an abundance of anything.*

Maybe you're like most people and don't realize what you already have.

In Second Corinthians chapter 12, Paul talks about a thorn in the flesh that was the messenger of Satan sent to buffet him (v. 7). He asked God three times to remove it from him, but God's reply was “. . . *My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness*” (v. 9).

Paul didn't realize that God had already given him the grace he needed to overcome the messenger of Satan. Paul had to learn how to put that grace into practice. He had to learn how to act on God's grace.

Grace is more than favor. Although grace is favor, it is also God's ability upon us that enables us to do what we could not do in and of ourselves.

In Exodus chapter 4, when God told Moses to go to the elders of the children of Israel, Moses was concerned that they would not believe he was sent to them by God. In reply to Moses' fears, God asked, “. . . *What is that in thine hand? And [Moses] said, A rod*” (V. 2).

Moses had to use what he had before God could go into action. When Moses cast the rod to the ground, it became a serpent. Only then was the power of God able to manifest. When Moses used what he already had, he obtained what he lacked.

The prophet Elisha understood this principle. He was approached by a widow whose two sons were about to be taken from her to pay her debts. When she asked Elisha for help, he replied, “. . . *What shall I do for thee? tell me, WHAT HAST THOU IN THE HOUSE?*” (2 Kings 4:2).

Notice that Elisha asked her for what she already had. The widow woman's need was not going to be

met by something she didn't possess yet. No. What she needed to get out of debt was already in her possession: a small jar of oil. Elisha then told her to borrow many jars from her neighbors and use her oil to fill the borrowed vessels. Her miraculous provision came from what she already possessed. (See 2 Kings 4:1–7.)

When David went into battle against Goliath, he took five smooth stones and his sling—a weapon he was very familiar with from past use—and refused to wear armor that didn't belong to him. More importantly, he remembered what God had previously done for him. David remembered the lions and bears

that he killed with the help of God. He recounted his past victories and was confident that God would deliver him again. (See 1 Sam. 17.)

David knew that he could rely on God. If you search your house without finding anything, remember that you have God—and God is more than enough.

Although you may not be able to place your hands on something physical,

you do have the promises of God. You can begin to move forward toward fulfilling your dreams by meditating on God's Word and letting it fill your heart. You can then put that Word in your mouth and speak to the mountains in your life (Mark 11:23).

Right now, you have everything you need to step out to do what God has called you to do. Remember, you are just taking a step. But after you have taken the first step, then you can take the next step and the next step. And before you know it, you are walking out the plan of God for your life.

So start making demands on what you already have. In the same way Moses threw down his staff and watched God go into action, you can use what you have and watch God give you what you need. ♥

You have everything you need to step out to do what God has called you to do.

Seed Thoughts

"The Lord will guide you always: he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail." — Isaiah 58:11 (NIV)

In the hustle and bustle of today's world, we are often encumbered by the many tasks that lie before us. Sometimes when I look at my schedule, I am overwhelmed, wondering how I am going to get everything done in the time allotted. At such times it is easy for me to lose my joy.

Joy is one of the most important commodities to keep in our lives. No one enjoys being around someone who is always grumpy and griping. I'm sure you have met people who find something negative to say about everything that happens to them; they complain almost all of the time. As a result, these people are not fun to be around. Some people need a personality transplant!

In my childhood I found that I always learned better when I had a teacher who was pleasant and full of joy. I can still remember my fifth grade teacher. She became my favorite. The characteristics that I still recall were her laughter, positive attitude, and patience with us as children. She attracted people to her like a magnet.

Joy draws people to you. The Word of God talks a lot about joy. When I am weary I like to quote the last part of Nehemiah 8:10, ". . . for the joy of the Lord is your strength." I have found that strength comes in joy. In Proverbs 17:22 we read, "A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones." I like the *New Living Translation* of that verse: "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit saps a person's strength."

I have found that in volatile situations, laughing is always better received than complaining. I remember an incident that happened to me several years ago. Our entire family, including our children and grandchildren, went to the lake for the Fourth of July holiday. We had a marvelous time and were on our way home when we decided to stop at a pizza restaurant to eat. The waitress brought our beverages, which were fairly large. We had just come from the heat of the day and we were all hot and thirsty. One of the grandchildren picked up his glass. It slipped out of his hand, and suddenly my entire lap was full of an ice-cold beverage. Needless to say it was a shock to my skin! My grandson looked at me, waiting for my reaction to the mishap. The first thing that came

out of my mouth was laughter. Then all of the family joined in. What could have been a disaster became a cherished memory that we've talked about time and time again. And we laugh every time we tell the story.

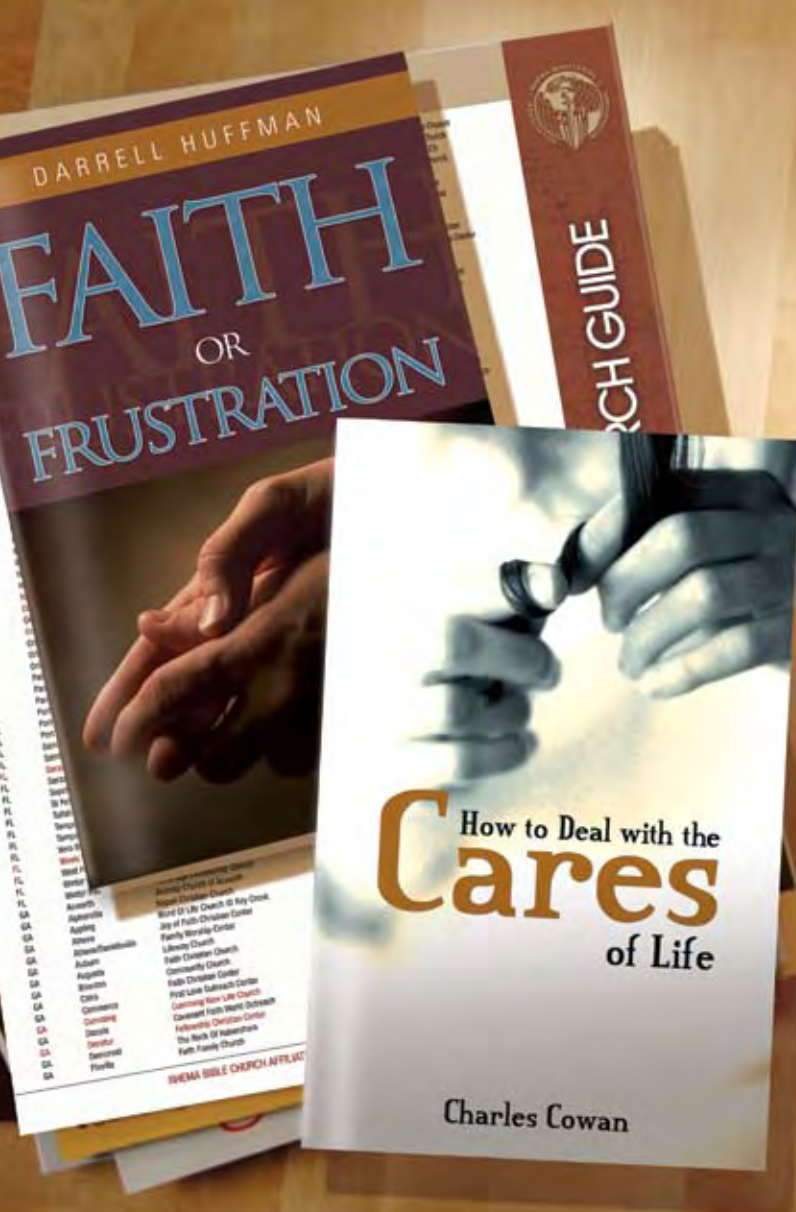
Whenever I think of joy my thoughts go to the writings of Paul. So many times he wrote about rejoicing in the Lord. One of my favorite books in the Bible is Philippians. This letter was written under the worst of circumstances. Paul was in jail—actually, we would probably call the place a dungeon. Yet in the midst of awful circumstances he wrote in Philippians 4:4, "*Rejoice in the Lord always; and again I say, Rejoice.*" Notice that Paul said to rejoice in the Lord. Paul could be full of joy in spite of his circumstances because he was rejoicing in the Lord.

You see, when you place your trust in God and have the kind of relationship with Him that Paul had, you can rejoice in spite of the circumstances around you. Why? Because as Paul wrote in Second Corinthians 2:14, "*Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ.*" We can be joyful because we know that with God on our side we will always come out as winners.

I want to encourage you to practice laughing. Laughter is contagious. So the next time you are tempted to cry or stress out, try laughing instead. When I can't find anything to laugh about, I look for humorous stories.

Let me close with this one: A minister had all of his remaining teeth pulled and had new dentures made. The first Sunday he preached only 10 minutes. The second Sunday he preached 20 minutes. But on the third Sunday he preached for an hour and 25 minutes. When some of the congregation asked him about this, he responded, "The first Sunday my gums were so sore it hurt to talk. The second Sunday my dentures were hurting a lot. The third Sunday I accidentally grabbed my wife's dentures and I couldn't stop talking!"
